Children & Families are especially welcome at both St Luke's and St John's and there are activities and Pew Bags available for children.

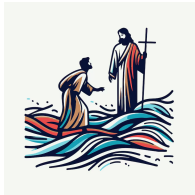
Communion is offered in both kinds at **the High Altar**. Wine is received from the chalice directly, if you'd prefer not to, then simply return to your seat down the side aisles after receiving the bread. You are also welcome to come forward for a blessing. **PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE VALUABLES IN THE PEWS.**

Gluten Free Wafers are available. Please let someone know when you arrive in church, and mention to the priest when you come forward for communion.

Hearing Loop is available throughout St John's – to use set your hearing aid to the 'T' setting.

Toilets and Baby Changing are found at the back of church to the left under the tower.

Fire/Emergency Exits are through the south (main) doors and north doors and if needed, the west (tower) doors. Please follow the directions of stewards and the emergency exit signs.



Welcome to St John's and St Luke's

This Sunday's Gospel is the account of Jesus walking on the Sea of Galilee to meet his amazed and terrified disciples in their boat as they are battered by a storm on the lake. In the early morning light, they think he is a ghost, but Peter, always the first to recognise Jesus, finds he too can walk on water as he goes toward his Lord, until his fear of the strong wind causes his faith to waver and he sinks. Jesus reaches out his hand to save him and when they reach the boat, the wind and the storm subsides. Jesus has divine authority over nature and his disciples, recognising this, worship him saying 'Truly you are the Son of God.'

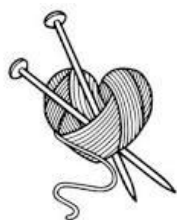
We Build Wednesdays - Continues this week

Support is available every day of the week - Mondays 2-4pm at St Mark's, Tuesdays 10-12 at St John's, Wednesdays 10.30am-1pm at Park Road Baptist Church, Thursdays 12-2pm at St Mark's and Fridays (from August 7th) 11am-2pm at St John's.
